#### **Attendance**

In the last week of term 5, Class 3/4M had the highest attendance with 97.4%. Well done!

The whole school attendance for the last week was 93%, and the attendance for the year to date has dropped slightly to 95.3%. We are aiming for our whole school attendance to be over 96% and we hope you can support us to meet this target.

The whole school attendance for Term 5 was 95.6% and 122 children had 100% attendance for the term. Great work!
