Following our snow days - welcome back to school! I would like to explain the reasons for closing school for 3 days last week and to thank you for your understanding and patience.

My aim is to keep school open if at all possible and if it is safe to do so. Each day in school is full of important learning and it is essential that days missed are kept to a minimum.

I received information from the multi-agency county group advising that "travel is not recommended unless absolutely necessary" and asking "all head teachers ... to inform their pupils and staff as quickly as possible on their decision." Having communicated with school staff throughout the week, I was not confident that we would have enough teachers who were able to get to school safely in order to be adequately staffed. Therefore to open the school would have been an unacceptable risk. Again, I thank you for your support and co-operation.

On Wednesday this week, we will be celebrating World Book Day. The children are welcome to dress as their favourite book character, and we have a few activities planned for the children during the school day.
