What	How
In class Teaching Assistant Support	Targeted support for pupils in class during lessons.
Teaching Assistant Led Interventions	Small group support in addition to main class teaching for: Maths, Reading, Writing, Phonics, Spelling. Targeted support for Accelerated Reader programme.
Emotional Literacy Support	Small group intervention for social and emotional support in order to be ready to learn.
Child and Family Support Worker	Support for children and families in order to support learning in the classroom.
Accelerated Reader	Ensure children are reading books which will support development; take quizzes to check their comprehension; allow teachers to carefully track and target pupils; in class support with reading.
Trips, visits and visitors	Financial support to enable children to participate in additional activities.
Counselling, Art Therapy, Pets as therapy	Support children in being ready to learn in the classroom.
Ongoing staff training	Read Write Inc Phonics and Spelling training.
