Dear Parent/ Carer,

Your child has been issued with a reading folder which contains a reading book, diary and a book mark. Please share this reading book with your child every day and write a comment in their diary to let us know how they get on. This will help them move along with our scheme.

Each time a new book is issued your child will also be given some Reading Trees with helpful hints for sharing their books. As we look at the comment in the reading diary we swap the Reading Trees to give fresh ideas and suggestions for parent and child reading. We change the books, assuming they have been shared with you and your child, two to three times per week depending on each child and the pace at which they develop their reading fluency.

In our experience children will read their book several times before this point is reached. Very early readers will have books with illustrations to talk about but no text at this stage; character's names and their pictures are in the reading record to help you describe and tell the story together.

During Parents' Evening I will chat with you about your child's reading progress and answer any queries you may have. If you have any questions beforehand please do not hesitate to ask any of the Foundation Team.
